Together we will create a signature event for the City of Belmont to showcase our community businesses and the musical talents of school district students.

The Save the Music Festival was developed by School-Force in response to on-going Belmont-Redwood Shores district budget cuts that threatened to eliminate the instrumental music program in all five elementary schools. Thanks to our volunteers and the groundswell of community support, School-Force has been able to maintain the high quality instrumental music program starting in 4th grade. With this early introduction to music, we find that more children participate, building a solid foundation for exceptional middle school participation. As a result, thirty-five percent of Ralston Middle School students continue in the school's music program, with many earning high awards from the California Music Educators Association.

Save the Music is expected to draw 5,000 people. The festival will be highly visible in Twin Pines Park on Sunday, October 4th, 2009. It is a one-day celebration of music, food, and fun for the whole community.
